

Temoc Creator and Entertainer

Stand-up comedian Aaron Aryanpur BA'00 has appeared on television and in comedy clubs, theaters and colleges across the country. Crowned the "Funniest Comic in Texas" in 2012, he made his national television debut on Fox's "Laughs" and was a semifinalist in both Comedy Central's "Up Next Talent Search" and NBC's "Stand-Up for Diversity" competitions.

Aryanpur's album "In Spite Of" made the Top 10 of both iTunes' and Billboard's comedy album charts. He also has appeared on the "Minivan Men" podcast with fellow comics Maz Jobrani ("Curb Your Enthusiasm") and Al Madrigal ("The Daily Show"). His work has been featured on Comedy Central Radio and 24/7 Comedy Radio.

With nearly 20 years of experience, Aryanpur also has been a contributing joke writer and a voice-over actor for a variety of programs. As a University of Texas at Dallas student in 1998, Aryanpur created Blaze, the first iteration of UTD's beloved mascot Temoc. He graduated from UT Dallas with a bachelor's degree in art and performance.


